Subject: Stop Mohammadreza's deportation to IRAN

To the Honourable Sean Fraser
Minister of Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship

I am writing this letter on behalf of No Deportations to Iran, a group of Iranians well aware of the consequences of deporting Iranian refugees to a country whose regime is well known as a fierce violator of human rights and freedom.

Under the name of No Deportations To Iran, we are gathering our efforts to create awareness among Canadians and inform our government about the risk of sending innocent people to Iran whose only sin is to be inspired by the freedom and human rights values of our country.

As you are aware, the people of Iran are under the rule of a cruel and oppressive regime. Many fled their home country and sought refuge in more just societies like Canada.

I would like to draw your attention to the point that the Iranian community has integrated well into Canadian societies and contributed their fair share in the short time of their presence in this country. Canadian-Iranians play their part in all levels of manufacturing and economic activities. Deporting the refugee seekers from Iran only endangers their lives and stops them from serving Canada, their chosen and beloved country.

May I ask you to order the related immigration bodies to refrain from deporting Mohammadreza Alamdari, detained in Rexdale Detention Centre, and other asylum seekers from Iran on a humanitarian basis because of the dire situation that they are in? Especially at this very sensitive time when Canada has taken punitive measures against the Iranian regime.

As you are well aware, the principle that refugees should not be returned to any country in which they could face the prospect of inhumane or humiliating treatment is well recognized in law and practice.

We need your attention on this sensitive subject more related to saving human lives than any other legal, financial and political interest. We strongly believe that the values that attracted us to become a part of this lovely country are still our politicians' primary guidelines to keep Canada the desirable country where human life has its un-equivalent importance.

We would appreciate it if you could consider stopping all deportations immediately to Iran until a significant change in human rights in that country.
